At the moment, JP's wife Ying is working on selling their current house then downgrading to a smaller house or apartment so she does not have to bear the burden of the huge mortgage. However, to keep Jessica in the same school until her graduation will be challenging after selling their house. Meanwhile, Ying is facing numerous other challenges without JP by her side.

We (JP's friends in the Bay Area) have set up a Trust Fund **JESSICA LI AND BRYAN LI TRUST** in the name of JP's two children (see next 2 pages for donation instruction). We strongly encourage everyone to help out. JP was such a wonderful person and many of us have been directly or indirectly touched by him. Any one attended his funeral was so proud of being JP's friend. As one of his co-workers from Applied Materials said: **"What a privilege to have JP in my life!"** If this would have happened to anyone else, JP himself would've done all his best to help-- that we know for sure!

JP's colleagues at Applied Materials are working in parallel to find ways to help JP's family.
